1. Potentially Fatal Diseases

Asbestos is often referred to as the **deadly dust** because all the health effects associated with it are potentially fatal. There are **four main conditions**:

- Asbestosis
- Heart failure
- Mesothelioma
- Lung & other cancers

Persons exposed to asbestos can die of heart failure brought on by infections that easily take hold of diseased lungs.

Most of the conditions or diseases do not appear overnight and can often take 20 or 30 years to develop following the exposure, making asbestos an insidious killer.
